#### **FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT:**

Chief Kane reported that the Department had 7 Calls this mast month and attended several meetings. (See Attached Sheet)

The Fire Department hopes to bid out the new Fire Truck in January 2016. They estimate the new truck would come in at a cost of \$380,000.00 to \$400,000.00. They hope to sell the truck they are replacing for \$25,000.00.

The Village Fire Extinguishers have just been inspected and all but two Fire personnel have completed their physicals.

#### **CODE ENFORCMENT OFFICER'S REPORT:**

CEO Gerald Parsons stated that so far this year he has processed 15 building permits and that was a record for the Village. (See Attached Sheet)

It was stated that homeowners are responsible for keeping the sidewalk in front of their property shoveled. The Village is looking into purchasing a UTV to plow and do other projects.

#### **HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDANT'S REPORT:**

Superintendent Page reported that the work on the North Side of Main Street was progressing and that they should be paying the driveway areas the week of 10/25-10/31.

The drain on Eastman place was plugged and the town used the Fire Truck wash it out. They think there is a Willow Tree that is causing the problem.

The black top on Oak Manor, Jones Bridge Road and Pleasant Street where the water main was have been repaired.

Repaired several curb boxes for water shutoffs.

Mr. Page got pricing on putting a pipe in the ditch on Mahoney Street and filling it in. The pipe alone would be \$9578.00 and with everything included it would be around \$14,000.00.

Leaf and Brush pick-ups will be 10/26/2015 & 11/09/2015.

They still have to put in some water shutoffs and install two hydrants.

The State looked at the ditch at Mr. Shaughnessy's and they have not gotten back to Mr. Page at this time.

#### **PURCHASE A UTV FOR THE VILLAGE:**

There was much discussion about what should be purchased to plow the sidewalks and do other projects throughout the year. There was a John Deere UTV with a "V" plow at a cost of \$15,897.54 and
